### **Asinocotto**

(.....) Fortunately, cook Giuliano Brenna - one-time protégé of Princess Diana's chef - offers food that is as right-on as his political stance. With dishes that range from orange-scented smoked swordfish and black gnocchi with clams to Brenna's special desserts (try the riso all'imperatrice), it is no wonder that the Asinocotto (literally the Cooked Ass) is attracting the attention of Rome's fastidious foodie columnists. Expect to pay about L50,000 (£17) plus wine.
